1. Hosts speakers and panels from political, private, and academic arenas, presenting timely topics to foster opportunities and improve economic conditions in local communities and the San Francisco Bay Area.
2. Serves as a catalyst through which government, private industry, and academia can work together collaboratively for the common good of Bay Area communities.
3. Strategically partners with key leaders and organizations to advance workforce development and to create opportunities for small business.
4. Promotes career education and job readiness training via its affiliate organization, the Regional Technical Training Center (RTTC).
5. Facilitates monthly networking meetings, allowing attendees to engage strategically, building the BABRT and collaboration to create alliances in pursuit of economic opportunities.
6. Supports RTTC in its collaborative efforts to develop sustainable training programs and career opportunities.
7. Operates as a regional clearinghouse of information regarding workforce development, entrepreneurship and the condition of underprivileged local communities.
8. Cultivates competitive professionals through RTTC's training programs.
9. Establishes job placement and entrepreneurial opportunities for RTTC graduates.
10. Functions as a change agent in shifting and advancing public policy issues to help underprivileged communities in becoming sustainable and meeting their basic needs.
